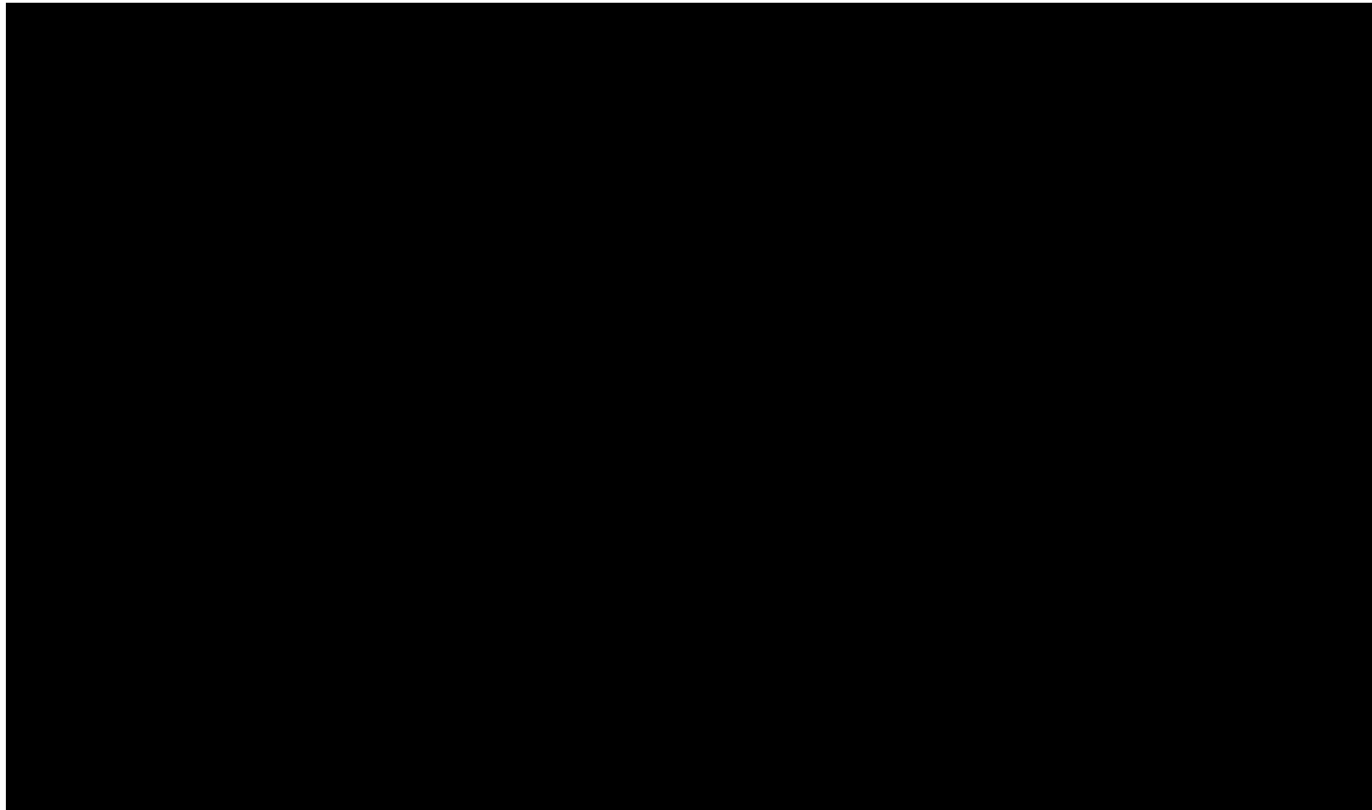

4. "ON BEHALF OF": If you are an individual who knows a veteran who could use help (IE, you are a neighbor, a friend, church member, etc.), and would like to get some assistance for this veteran, please register here. You will be the person/representative of that Veteran.
